Repaving of Swim Club Lane

As you are already aware, the condition of the pavement on Swim Club Lane has deteriorated significantly in the last few years. Swim Club Lane is scheduled to be repaved this summer by the City of Brentwood. The City of Brentwood has begun the scheduling process for repaving projects for the Summer of 2018, but no specific dates have been scheduled yet.

The Board of Directors of BSC has been in contact with the City. Once we have further information regarding the repaving of Swim Club Lane, we will communicate details to the members regarding alternate parking arrangements for the time access to Swim Club Lane will be limited due to the repaving project.

Reminders

- Please observe the rule that no glass containers are allowed at BSC. Should glass break and end up in the pool, we may be required to close, drain, clean and refill the pool, costing both time and significant expense. The easy way to avoid this problem is not to bring glass to BSC. The Board has asked Jim Houska and the staff to enforce this rule.
- Please park all bikes, scooters, strollers, etc. near the bike racks/tennis courts on the east parking lot. We appreciate your cooperation in not leaving these items in front of the Club. We want to provide for easy access for all.
- Slow Down! Please note that the speed limit on Swim Club Lane is 10 MPH. It is important that every member slow down in coming up and down Swim Club Lane. There are simply too many kids, pedestrians, bikers and neighbors who make their way down Swim Club Lane in the summer to ignore the speed limit. Please take a few extra seconds—someone's life may be at stake. Also, please slow down on the streets approaching Swim Club Lane, especially Rosalie.
- Children under the age of 10 must be accompanied by someone at least 13 years old.
- No food or drink may be in the pool or at the side of the pool. This is a Health Department regulation that must be observed. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation.
- Please check the lost and found regularly and take your items home. Rafts cannot be stored at BSC and will be disposed of on a daily basis.

Member ID System

Guests need to be accompanied by a member at check-in and will be required to sign in as a guest under the member's identification. It remains Club policy that a guest can visit the Club no more than three times in any given season. Guests must also pay a fee of \$5 upon entry. This year BSC will use wrist bands to identify guests and ensure that applicable guest fees are paid.
